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Application Requirements for Years 7 - 12

Minimum Academic Standards

Entry to this academy requires students to demonstrate the following achievement standards on their most recent report card:

- achieve a minimum 'A' standard in any Vocational Education subjects studied

AND

- achieve no less than a 'C' in any other subject.

Supporting Documentation

- **Years 9-12 students** are required to submit a letter of recommendation from a Vocational Education teacher at Tullawong SHS, to confirm that they demonstrate industry standards of behaviour and effort.
- **Years 7 and 8 students** are required to provide a written letter of recommendation from their primary school principal, outlining their achievements within the enterprise field.
- Other relevant documentation such as, club membership details, photographic evidence of work within field of expertise, a portfolio of work
- A letter of reference from an outside organisation **and** a questionnaire completed by an approved Industry Representative

Interview Requirements

- Students across all year levels are required to attend a formal interview.
