Tullawong State High School will receive

## This funding will be used to

- Create a mobile platform of student hired iPads across the school.
- Implement a whole school reading and writing program to increase reading and writing results in NAPLAN.
- Increase the percentage of Year 9 students at or above the NAPLAN National Minimum Standard in Reading and Writing to 88% in 2019.
- Increase the percentage of Year 9 students in the NAPLAN upper two bands in Numeracy to 18% in 2019.
- Sustain the percentage of Year 12 students attaining a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) to 100% in 2019.
- Implement the NEW QCE and new syllabi for Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) students.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a C or better in English to 85% in 2019.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a C or better in Mathematics to 80% in 2019.
- Implement Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) across the entire school.
- Implement Indigenous language into Year 7 in 2019.
- Implement North Coast Flexible Learning Program.

## Our initiatives include

- Embed "Write That Essay" as a core teaching methodology in all lessons all subjects in Years 7, 8 and 9. The online tool for Write that Essay will be accessible by all students 7 to 12 through IGNITE and English Lessons.
- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards in our IMMERSION classes.
- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching Reading through IGNITE classes.
- Embed mentoring program for senior students through IGNITE classes reviewing targets and goals at each Reporting period.
- Engage local Indigenous Elders through a reference group to endorse our Indigenous language program.
- Create and build infrastructure to implement North Coast Flexible Learning Program to engage highly at risk students.
- Build leadership capacity throughout the school utilising 360 degree feedback processes and authentic feedback through Personal Growth Plans (PGP)
- Continue to implement the New QCE through teacher professional development and collaboration across clusters within our district.
- Implement PBL across the school to create a safe supportive inclusive environment for all students.

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## Our school will improve student outcomes by

<p>Employing two TA04 teacher aides in Senior schooling to assist in the New QCE implementation and the expansion of Vocational Education and Training (VET) pathways for students.</p> <p>Employing a Chaplin to increase student support and assist focused on students who are disengaged from classroom learning and require significant levels of wellbeing support for family trauma.</p>	\$174,736
<p>Purchasing 400 iPads to create a mobile platform of student hired devices for equitable student access to Information and Communication Technology (ICT). These devices are critical for our whole school Reading and Writing program for students to access online tools and digital diaries.</p>	\$165,510
<p>Engaging a whole school writing program "Write That Essay" to enhance the writing skills of all our students across the entire school. All teachers will deliver targeted teaching of writing to Year 7, 8 and 9 students. English and IGNITE teachers will deliver Write that Essay to year 10, 11 and 12 students.</p> <p>Providing school specific professional development targeting systemic initiatives and whole of school priorities.</p> <p>Providing students with real life learning experiences external to the classroom and the school.</p>	\$80,500
<p>Inclusion: Creating North Coast Flexible learning program to engage highly at risk disengaged students.</p> <p>Enhance and build facilities to engage at risk students.</p> <p>Creation and purchase of resources for our new Indigenous Language program to further connect and engage our Indigenous community.</p>	\$168,000
